
Station 1: Sleigh Ride

Two students may go at once. Both must ride the scooter using your bottom only. Race down, grab ONE beanbag, and return it to the square near the starting line. Repeat with the second beanbag. The first person to get both beanbags into the square wins!

Station 2: New Year's Ball Drop

How many times can you get the basketball to drop into the hoop? Take shots from the numbered spots near the hoop. Keep track of your score by adding your points together!



Station 3: Christmas Wreath Toss

Pretend the rings are wreaths. Toss them toward the ring target. How many can you get to land on the pole?



Station 4: Snowball Catch

Using a yarn ball, play catch with your partner. Count the number of catches you make without letting the ball hit the ground.



Station 5: Down the Chimney

Who can get all of their gifts into the chimney the quickset? Pretend the bucket is the chimney and the beanbags are the

gifts. Using and underhand throw stand behind the cones, toss the beanbags toward the bucket. If you miss, run to get it and then return to your starting spot. The first player to get all 5 beanbags into the bucket wins!



Station 6: Winter Olympics Training

Using carpet squares turned upside down, 'skate' to the one of the spots and perform the exercise as many times as you can. Next, skate to the another spot and perform that exercise.

After going to two spots, skate back to the start. If you have time, stretch your muscles until asked to switch stations.



Station 7: Stuff the Stocking

One person in the group will hold onto the stocking. The other members in the group will toss the fluff balls. The student holding the stocking will attempt to catch as many as he/she can.

Take turns be the stocking holder.



Station 8: Light the Menorah

How fast can your group get all of the balls from the blue bin on top of the cones? Start the stop watch and then work cooperatively. If you have time, try to beat your score on your second turn.
